Since the onset of this virus, we have had 72 residents and 21 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We have had 20 staff members return to work. We have had 53 residents recover. We performed additional mass testing of residents on September 1st. We performed mass testing of staff on 9/28/20 and 10/1/20 and will continue to test staff every Monday and Thursday going forward.

We are getting closer to the Outdoor Visitation plan being underway and are excited to get this plan in place. In the upcoming week, we will be reaching out via letters and phone calls to families to explain the procedures and requirements of which visitors must adhere. Visitation will be at discretion of facility management and will have to account for things such as inclement weather and resident's current condition.

With the changing in weather, we are experiencing an increase in deliveries of items to residents. We are continuing to accept deliveries of items that can be sanitized or washed. These items should be delivered between **9am and 5pm**, and should be labeled to ensure your loved one receives it.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 72 residents and 21 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We have had 20 staff members return to work. We have had 53 residents recover. We have performed mass testing of staff on 10/19/20, 10/22/20, and 10/29/20. We are continuing to test our staff every Monday and Thursday going forward until county prevalence rates allow for a decrease in frequency of testing.

We have begun Outdoor Visitation and have been so excited to see our families again. Please contact us during business hours Monday through Friday to schedule an outdoor visit with your loved one. The schedule currently runs on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and alternating Saturdays and Sundays. Visitation remains at discretion of facility management and will have to account for things such as inclement weather and resident's current condition.

We are in the process of beginning Indoor Visitation and are working towards a plan that meets the requirements as outlined by local, state and federal authorities. When that plan is in place, we will be scheduling indoor visitations with families and residents.
