Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We have had no newly identified cases of COVID-19 in our facility in the last 14 days. Our cumulative total number of identified cases of COVID-19 in our facility is 95 for residents and 31 for staff members.

We will continue to perform routine testing for identification of COVID-19 of staff twice weekly until otherwise noted.

We are excited to restart outdoor visitation on Tuesday March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Please call our main line to schedule a time. As a reminder, you can schedule video chats by calling our main line.

Starting Friday March 12, 2021, we are allowing for the delivery of restaurant and home prepared food for residents. We ask that restaurant delivered food be made contactless. Please note, though we will make every effort to do so, we cannot ensure that restaurant delivered food will be delivered immediately, especially if it is outside of the 9am-4pm time frame.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

We are offering outdoor visitation at this time on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and alternating Saturday and Sundays. Please call our main line to schedule a time.

We are offering limited indoor visitation for residents that have received both doses of the COVID-19 vaccination, with at least 14 days having passed since the second dose. For example, if a resident has an indoor visit scheduled for March 30<sup>th</sup>, the resident would have to have had their second dose of the COVID-19 vaccination no later than March 16<sup>th</sup>. These visits will be in our Activities Room, will be limited to 2 visitors at a time and will be scheduled for 30 minutes. Please call our main line to schedule a time. As a reminder, you can schedule video chats by calling our main line.

Residents, regardless of their COVID-19 vaccination status, wishing to leave the facility to go out anywhere other than a doctor's appointment, must be quarantined for 14 days in the designated quarantine area of the facility after they return. We cannot guarantee that resident will return to original room after end of 14-day quarantine. The exception to the 14-day quarantine requirement would be if a resident has had COVID-19 and recovered in the previous 90 days.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. ## WEEKLY UPDATE

**March 4, 2021**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. On February 25, 2021, we identified 3 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 3 suspected cases of COVID-19. Our total number of newly identified cases of COVID-19 in our facility is 95 for residents and 31 for staff members.

We will continue to perform routine testing for identification of COVID-19 of staff twice weekly.

Unfortunately, Outdoor Visitation has to be suspended at this time until 14 days has passed since last identified positive case of COVID-19. If no other cases are identified, we will be able to resume visitation Friday March 19, 2021. We will keep families updated through this weekly update letter and calls.

We are still asking that deliveries of items be limited to non-perishable, factory sealed foods delivered between 9am and 4pm daily. We are aiming to have restaurant deliveries re-instated in the coming weeks but have not confirmed a time or date of that to start back. We will notify families and residents when we are able to allow delivery of restaurant food.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.
